EU Project Slam for Museums

From 9-12 November 2017, Ghent will be home to NEMO's 25th Annual Conference! For four days, NEMO gathers representatives from European museum organisations, museum experts, and policy makers and stakeholders from the European cultural sector to exchange expertise, discuss and to network.

This year's topic "Open heart surgery" will take an open look at the core of museums: how can museum collections help develop a sense of identity – both for the museum itself and its community? What are the contemporary approaches to museum collecting today? How must we challenge traditional museum thinking and practice, and redefine the museum's role in socially and politically changing times?

NEMO invites you to submit a proposal for your project presentation. The presentation should not exceed 8 mins. The presentations will take place on **11 November 2017**.

You can choose whether to present your project vision, your approach, your biggest challenges, unexpected outcomes or the European aspect that your project tackles. Feel free to use interactive, entertaining, usual or unusual presentation methods as Pecha Kucha, Slam speech etc.

For all selected presenters

NEMO covers 2 hotel nights in Ghent for selected presenters. They will also be granted free entry to all conference sessions.

Required Paper

1. An abstract of your presentation (subject, content, method), not exceeding 300 words
2. A short summary about the project and yourself, not exceeding 150 words

Deadline for Paper Submission

Abstract and papers should be submitted until **8 September 2017** to office@ne-mo.org.

You will be notified by 22 September, if your proposal is accepted for the slam.
