

This <u>NEMO Learning Exchange</u> will be hosted by Sarah Fortmann-Hijazi and Salma Jreige, project management team of "<u>Multaka: Meetingpoint Museum</u>", with team members of the Multaka project Berlin as well as the partners of the International Multaka Network.
