ABOUT THE PROGRAMME

The leading principle of NEMO's activities for members is to empower the network to help professionalise museum work through exchanging and discussing with colleagues from other countries. The aim of the learning exchange is to add to the experience of museum organisation staff members and to strengthen crossborder work. The learning exchanges are free of costs for NEMO members after a successful application.

Participants will be reimbursed their travel, accommodation and subsistence costs through a lump sum of 600 Euro. The sum can only be transferred AFTER the Training Course and with a proof of participation and a feedback of the activity.
