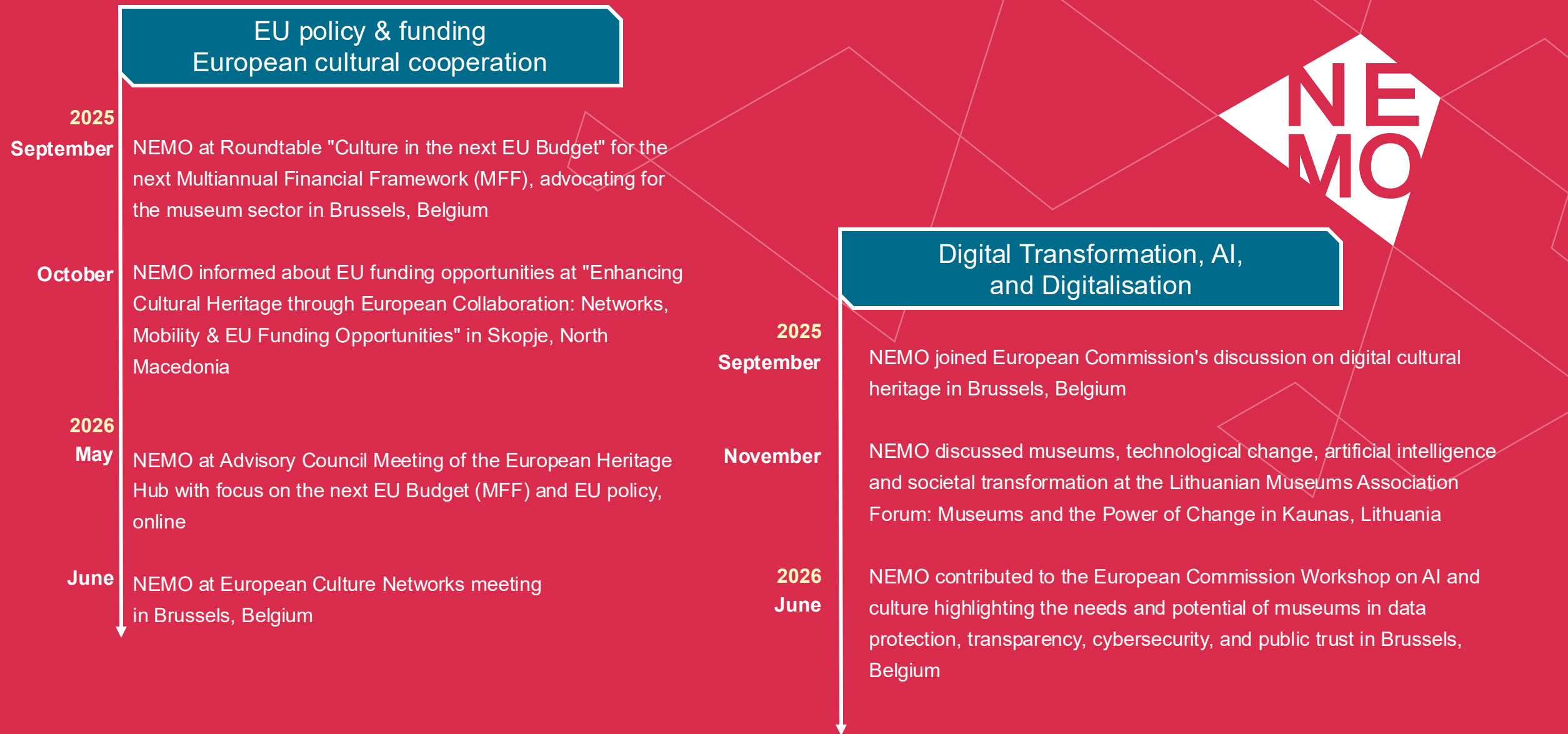

2025 – 2027

TOWCHED – Transforming European education through heritage and the arts

Explores how arts and cultural heritage collections can support Education for Sustainable Development (ESD) and lifelong learning. Running from January 2025 to December 2027, it focuses particularly on empowering children and young people through innovative learning experiences. In 2026, 10 museums across Europe participate in the project.

2024 – 2029

ECHOES – European Cloud for Heritage OpEn Science

Aims to build the European Collaborative Cloud for Cultural Heritage (ECCCH), a shared digital infrastructure for heritage professionals which will connect institutions, data, tools, and researchers across the EU, enabling collaboration, preservation, and innovation.

2025 – 2028

SHIFT – Eco-Guidelines for Networks

Supports international cultural network-organisations in reducing their environmental impact and embedding sustainable practices into their operations.
